Prophetic Words for 2022 - Part 2 (Don Davis)

We wanted to circle back and remind you about what we believe the Lord is directing us or rather, inviting us, to do.

It's in 7 main points.

- 1. We have a direction (actually an invitation) and a revealed will from the Holy Spirit. Are you hearing it also?
- We're a prophetic church and we're apostolic in our nature. It's no surprise that we have received this invitation. What an honor to host Him and receive from Him. Every week we ask, what does He want to do?
- What is He desiring to do? What's the rhema word for this week? We know that He wants to transform us, so, He tells us what to do...how to do. Gives directions.
- We value the prophets and we align with Chuck Pierce and others, but it's important that we receive direct revelation for us. Our assignment is in the Pacific NW. It's a different place and with different people.
- Are you in agreement with the themes that have been expressed?
- The question is...what will we do with this word?
- What can we do to enhance our mission? How can we help each other out?

2. What did we hear? What was it? We're invited to go deep in Him.

- This is an era of the Holy Spirit. While the amazing and the miraculous will occur, it will be the time of His being with us, walking around us, going through us and enjoying our love, affections, and worship.
- Relationship will be primary. Worship will be primary. <u>Deep relationship will yield a kingdom</u> lifestyle.
- Your time spent in personal worship, praise, and prayer will play a huge factor in the days, months and years ahead. We'll need to cultivate it now...cultivate it better.
- We'll focus on how real relationship works. We'll need adjustments.
- Authentic Christianity. What is it? It's easily talked about, but we'll be living it.
- We practice hosting the Holy Spirit / making Him feel welcome. That is going to intensify!!
- Ministry will be in its proper place. More on that as the message unfolds.
- We know we're in a warfare and that it will intensify, but we're still on track...on task with what He's given to us.

This deepening relationship will ground you. It will stabilize you.

- Miracles, gifts, and assignments will flow.
- Supernatural will be a part of your life. You'll have a developed knower and be able to tell what's real and what's false.
- Relationship will be primary. Thus, you won't be in self-seeking ministry, nor will you be competing for one. The Lord will find a fit for you. You won't need to carry worldly ambition with you.
- You'll have a greater security. Comfortable in who you are.
- You'll discover that some...or many...of your held beliefs were primitive. You'll be able to let them go. You are maturing. The relationship is maturing.

• The relationship will sustain us through the shaking and the hardship. It would not surprise me if the U.S. gets shaken pretty hard.

Some more reminders on what was brought on 9 January:

A continued shaking of the U.S. and a warfare for the harvest. No need to explain all that. We've been given words to watch and pray and be ready for this spring.

- 3. In '22, we'll see signs of radical Christianity (or it will seem so). It will be an "all in" movement. This will stem from <u>real relationship</u> that will develop or has been developed. Kingdom lifestyle through relationship.
- It will seem radical (and even dangerous) to unbelievers, the lukewarm, and to traditional churches. They'll speak out against it, but it will inspire many to join. I didn't sense all the details about this, but we'll know it when we see it and we'll want to be a part of it.
- It will win many people over as they will say, "I want that." It wasn't that I just sensed it. I **felt the intensity** of the movement. (After I wrote this, I remembered David Wilkerson's vision from 1973 where he spoke about this dynamic.)
- Holy Spirit will be appointing leaders from the different generations to lead their groups. We'll need to respect this. Those leaders will have an anointing to connect. People will connect with them and their message.

Further comments:

This is the development of the remnant church. It will separate from mainline Christianity. It will not ally with politics (Stark). Some...or many from evangelical Christianity will come over to the remnant. Remember that evangelicalism is currently trending downward (Barna Reports). Evangelicals (with their many denominations) have lost ground through the past 30 years. What has started is the era of Holy Spirit.

- Man had better be careful with what he tries to put his hand to.
- 4. In this seemingly radical Christianity, I also sensed that this new wave will set a different, uncompromising tone in modeling the faith and Christian leadership.
- Believers will not be bribed or bought with money, nor will they be self-seekers.
- Again, this will be authentic Christianity. True to Christ and Biblical values. (Our money might be worthless soon anyway.)
- Many new leaders will come from the newer generations such millennials and Gen Z and they will
 understand the importance of trust.
- I sensed that these believers would rather die than compromise or surrender their faith and they will be powerful witnesses.

Further comments:

- There will not be compromises made with the world and with politics. Sin will be classified as sin.
- Holy Spirit is willing to work with people (and with us), but there won't be ridiculous reinterpretations of scriptures or untenable agreements with gross sins.

- There will be a sense of willingness to face death or be put to death like the "ancient church". Saints will consider it an honor.
- Kingdom will be first.
- 5. For Firestorm, my sense for '22 is that we will see more people come "back home." Many people we know will come back to God and will start a fresh walk with Him and in a deeper way. They'll find a home with us and will feel comfortable. Why? Because we're coming into authentic Christianity. Vulnerability and protection. You reveal yourself and I (we) will protect you!
- They will have **found their tribe**. We'll need to recognize that, make them feel welcome, and **extend ourselves** to ensure that they feel welcomed and that they fit. In the past, we've been more about people finding their gifts, their roles to play, and to go wherever they want.
- Keep in mind that we are a tribe that will have specific callings and gifts. Hint: Relationship and leading others into it.
- My sense for '22 is that we're going to be a sanctuary and place of safety for many. And, there's
 going to be a close-knit union that is already being woven together. (Melinda's word.) It's called
 authentic Christianity.
- "Here's my story. I'm a trophy of grace. Yes, it's a mess, but there it is."
- Part of our growth will be about how we message about ourselves.
- There is already a family and tribal anointing that's happening with us.
- 6. For Firestorm, I want to pull in the last two points together (building and people coming home). There will be more people...new people...buildings...and levels of discomfort.
- Why the discomfort? There will be more details, more soul care, more energies expended, and...more sacrifices for the team.
- But with the people that will come, Firestorm will also develop a "deep bench" (as they say in sports). People will bring talents, gifts, become activated, and will want to get in the game. There's no need to compete.
- As leaders, we'll need to be **flexible and creative.** Services and activities will have new power and impacts from saints that are seasoned.
- Discipline to maintain order and decency will also be the theme of the day because many are going to be activated in the spirit and be unafraid to share their faith or gift. We do pretty well now, but there will be some "blessed mess" as time goes on. Flex!! Let's not get twisted in knots.
- Trust the leadership that they know what's going on. It's a wonderful gift and art to lead services like this.

Further comments:

- A vulnerability will be part of this era of Holy Spirit. There's a natural fear about that now.
- Testimonies of deliverance and freedom will be welcomed and needed.
- We'll need that for ourselves also.
- There will be a blessing for that authentic Christianity...faith will arise and miracles will take place.
- 7. One more thing. Prepare your mindsets that we'll have to share resources someday. Perhaps soon. We'll need to depend on each other.

This ridiculous situation with Russia might reveal some real vulnerabilities. What could happen?

- We don't have the "A team" in the White House or the Pentagon.
- We have thoughtless and inept people working in government today. Not good at three-dimensional chess.
- Electronic and cyber hacking can escalate into some real supply problems.
- Sabotage oil refineries, rail lines, etc. Disruption of supplies.
- Then the real tensions can build. That can result in a shooting war.
- Asymmetric warfare within the U.S. Guerillas inside the U.S.
- The border is open. It wouldn't be hard to smuggle a small army or teams across.

Closing Comments

Where are we going? <u>Kingdom lifestyle through relationship!!</u> Live intentionally. Set your life up accordingly (as best you can)! Stop bumbling along. (Melinda's story.) Let go of rubbish. Stop living a fragmented life! (Book of James speaks a lot about that.) You have a purpose; be intentional about that! Get up and walk toward your destiny.

Philippians 3:8 says, "More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them mere rubbish, so that I may gain Christ," (NAS)

So, each time we gather, remember the purpose and themes that have been expressed. The prophetic words spoken and of course, we hope you're in agreement.

Demonstration: Speak into everybody you're connected to and into everything you own. Say: You have a purpose. Your purpose is to help me reach my destination and it is called relationship!
